Career Studios are student-centered, drop-in spaces designed to offer accessible, peer-led career guidance. Career Studios are staffed by student Peer Career Coaches (PCC) with support from professional Career Coaches. Services include help with resumes, cover letters, job/internship searches and referrals to professional Career Coaches for more in-depth assistance. These Career Studios will be in multiple campus spaces and available virtually, with one location in Student Life's <u>Buckeye Commons</u> at the Ohio Union. Buckeye Commons is a new center designed as an open, welcoming, multi-purpose space where students can connect, build community, and access resources that enhance their ability to engage, learn and thrive.

We are currently recruiting Peer Career Coaches for Spring 2026 and for the 2026-2027 academic year. This role offers valuable training and career knowledge to help you support your peers while advancing your own professional development.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide one-on-one and virtual drop-in assistance to undergraduate students on resume and cover letter development.
- Educate students on <u>NACE (National Association of Colleges and Employers) Career</u> Readiness Competencies, interviewing strategies and available career resources.
- Assist students with Handshake, LinkedIn and other career technology platforms and tools.
- Connect students with relevant career resources and inform them about ethical internship/job search practices.
- Participate in training sessions with other Peer Career Coaches and professional staff.
- Support career-related events and activities sponsored by the Office of Student Life.
